

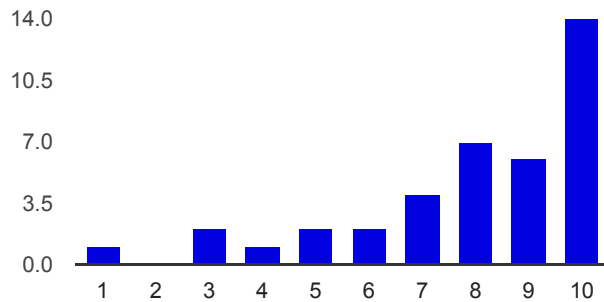

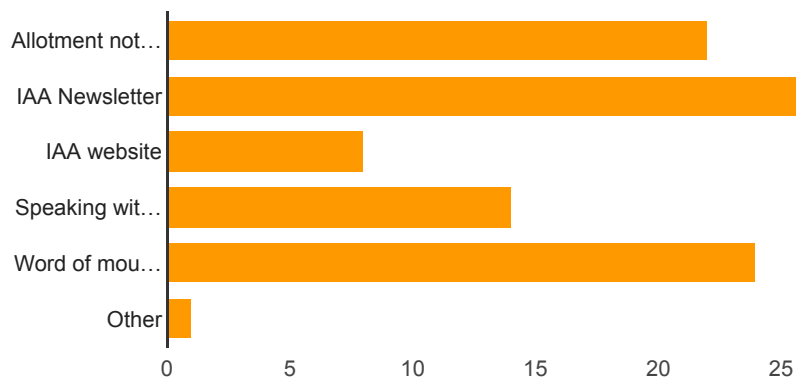

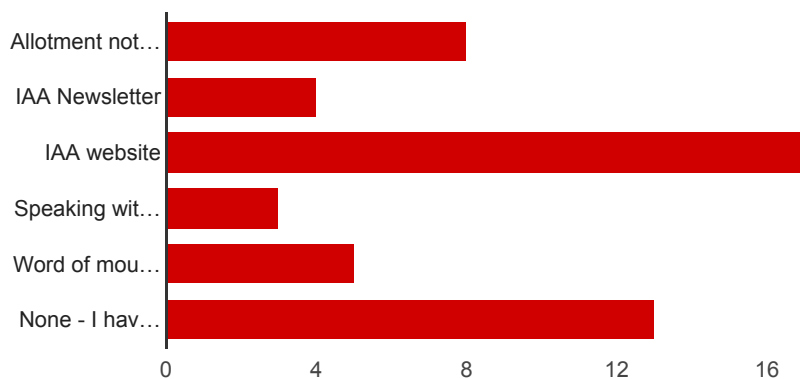
How do you regularly find out about allotment news?

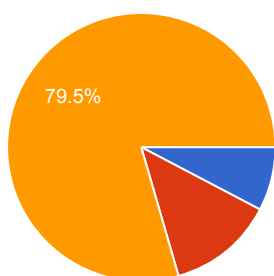

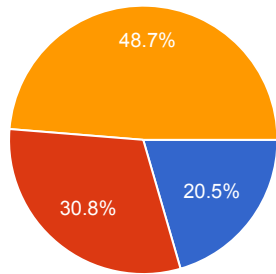

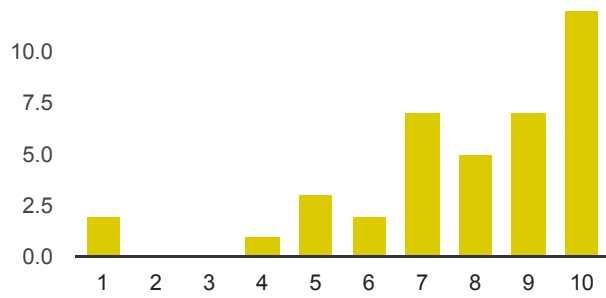

Would you like to receive IAA news via Facebook?

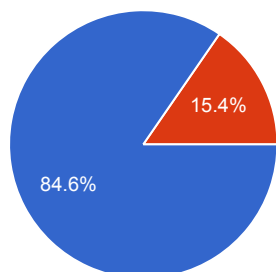


How useful do you find the monthly newsletter?



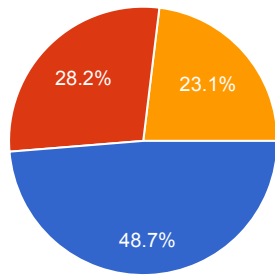

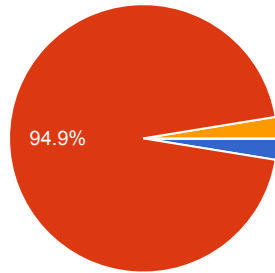
